Dear Families and Friends of the Ss Michael and John's Community,

Welcome to our second newsletter of the year. It is fabulous to walk around and see how well the children have settled back into the routines of the day, especially our Prep students who look as if they have been at school for much longer than two weeks. Our buddies are doing a great job caring for our preppies, supporting them with the morning routines and being there when needed in the playground.

The school is currently in the process in moving from CareMonkey to the Parent Access Module (PAM). Your child's medical information and family contact details will need to be entered into PAM by the end of next week (Friday 21st Feb). PAM will provide you with an up to date school calendar, newsletter, important notices and your child's report. We will be ceasing to use CareMonkey from Monday 24th February. If you require assistance in setting up PAM please see the instructions on page 3 of the newsletter or contact the school.

A reminder that all absences must be reported to the school. You are able to this via the Parent Access Module (PAM) or the Skoolbag App.

If you are the holder of a Health Care Card, the school requires a copy for our records. This card qualifies your child/ren for the state government Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) of \$125 which is paid to the school on your behalf. Anna is then able to deduct that amount from your school fee account.

Next Monday and Tuesday evenings we have the Building the Team meetings (formerly GTK's). An information letter is attached to the newsletter. As we want the focus of these meetings to be about building the relationship between your child and yourself with the teacher, we ask that siblings do not attend. A crèche will run in the Performing Arts room and the gate near the portable will be open for your convenience.

SMJ Horsham Facebook Page Acceptable Use Guidelines:

• SMJ Horsham Facebook page has been set up as an informational and promotional tool about what's happening at Ss Michael and John's Primary and to celebrate our school community. We aim to keep our parents and community informed in an inclusive way and to create a social page that all can access. To ensure this page is an enjoyable place for all of our parents and community to visit and connect with, these guidelines must be adhered to.
